Please note that entries will be accepted only thru DogShow.ca – paper entries and entries thru other online entry services will not be accepted.

These events are being held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

The Atlantic Labrador Retriever Club (ALRC) will consider the judging of Labrador Retrievers by Michael Lanctot on Sunday April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 (Show 3) as a breed booster. Suitable prizes will be offered for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Male, Select Female, Winners Male, Winners Female, Best Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Altered in Breed.

### Championship Point Ratings

A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

<b>Dogs Competing*</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3-5</b>	<b>6-9</b>	<b>10-12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
<b>Points Allocated</b>	<b>0</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b>

\* Includes the dog awarded winners.

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All-Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion it must win at least 10 points under 3 different judges, which includes at least one 2-point win. This 2-point win must be at the breed or group level.

**All exhibitors must cover the floor of their grooming area. Plastic, paper or fabric material which may be secured with painter's tape. (Duct tape is NOT permissible.) The floors have recently been replaced and there is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for uncovered grooming space.**

**All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the show site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the show grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.**
