

RV Parking:

1. *RV Parking* – *Thursday, August 3, 2023 @ 9 am to 10 pm, at which time the entrance gate will be closed.* All arrivals after 10 pm, please proceed to the North American Entrance to be escorted to your parking space.

- If you have prepaid for a spot in our Handicapped area, you must provide a valid, government issued handicapped placard, and if you do not have one of these, we will have to assign you a space in Lot 10 or 11.
- 3. All motorhomes and trailers in Lot 10 (grass) must have boards placed under the tires. Please bring leveling materials for your unit.
- 4. Motorhome generators must be vented up with an exhaust pipe extension (mandatory, no matter the lot).
- 5. Please ensure **GENERATORS ARE OFF** between the hours of **11:00 PM and 6:00 AM** this is the designated "quiet time" for our friends and neighbours.
- 6. Complimentary Shower Trailer provided by the Alberta Kennel Club ask at the AKC desk for directions or follow the signs the showers are East of the Fountain "Dog Spa".
- 7. There is no overnight tenting or sleeping in vehicles permitted at Spruce Meadows.
- 8. <u>No Open Fires</u> of any kind (wood or propane) are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows.
- 9. Absolutely NO dumping of grey water or sewage on Spruce Meadows grounds.
- 10. Water & electrical hook-ups are NOT available on Lots 10, 11 or handicapped area for RV units.
- 11. All RV parking is at your own risk: THE ALBERTA KENNEL CLUB IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR WEATHER RELATED DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY. PLEASE BE PREPARED FOR UNFORSEEN EVENTS ESPECIALLY WIND AND/OR HAIL.
- 12. <u>If you must leave the show grounds</u>, dogs in your care must be moved inside. DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN ANY OUTDOOR ENCLOSURE. FAILURE TO COMPLY will result in IMMEDIATE EXCUSAL from the show.
- 13. All Set -ups are required to have a contact phone number posted in case of emergency.
- 14. No balloons of any sort are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows they frighten the horses!

Parking:

- Free parking is permitted in Lot 7, between B-Barn and C-Barn, and along the east side of K-Barn and E-Barn only. PLEASE NOTE THAT PARKING LOT 7 WILL BE CLOSED FROM 9PM FRIDAY AUG 4 TO 5AM SATURDAY AUG 5 FOR MAINTENANCE.
- 2. Designated Handicapped parking areas are between K Barn (South Side) and the Wash Bays, the North End of B & C Barn. Please observe and respect the Handicapped (clearly marked) and Designated Parking (clearly marked) areas.
- 3. The Alberta Kennel Club, and Spruce Meadows reserve the right to have vehicles towed that are in areas other than described, this includes those areas that are designated "No Parking."
- 4. The speed limit on the grounds (including the RV Parking area) of Spruce Meadows is 15 km/hour.

- 5. Any indignities to the Staff of Spruce Meadows or to the volunteers of the Alberta Kennel Club will result in IMMEDIATE EXPULSION from the shows. Thank you for your cooperation!
- 6. All parking is a privilege at Spruce Meadows. Anyone abusing these privileges will be excused immediately from the show, and all future shows on this venue by the parking authorities and/or show superintendent.

K-Barn Reserved Benching:

- 1. K-Barn Reserved Benching Thursday, August 3, 2023 @ 1 pm
- 2. Please bring your own power cords (at least 100' in length) and sturdy duct tape. <u>All power cords in the</u> <u>aisles of the K-barn must be taped to the floor with duct tape for the length of the cord as it lays on the</u> <u>concrete floor</u>. This is for the safety of all those benching in the barn and is required by Spruce Meadows.
- 3. If you are leaving dogs in the stalls, your contact information must be visible in your benching area in the event of an emergency.
- 4. <u>Absolutely no smoking</u> (either tobacco or cannabis) in the barn at any time!
- 5. You are responsible for leaving your stall as you found it.... **CLEAN!** Brooms, dust pans and a couple of shop vacs will be available in K-Barn to assist you in cleaning your benching space. Please remove all duct tape from the floor when lifting your power cord.

On Monday after move-out, those exhibitors leaving a dirty stall behind will be noted by the show committee and future requests for benching in the K-Barn may be denied.

6. All indoor benching must be vacated 1 hour following Best in Show on Monday, Aug 7, 2023.

All-Alberta Ring & North American Ring Outdoor Reserved Day Tenting:

Private golf carts are not permitted on any field at any time.

- 1. Outdoor Reserved Benching move in Thursday, August 3, 2023 @ 2 pm.
- 2. Absolutely no vehicles on the fields at any time, please ensure you have a cart/trolley to move your items to your reserved benching spot.
- 3. Once the show commences you are welcome to drive into the designated Pick-up / Drop-off area on the north and south side of the wash bay areas. This area will be in operation all day. THERE WILL BE AN OFF-LOADING AREA WHERE YOUR CARGO CAN BE LEFT UNTIL YOU RETURN FROM PARKING YOUR VEHICLE IN LOT 7. Note that you only have 15 minutes to drop off/pick up. The area will be supervised.
- 4. <u>No smoking</u> in the benching area or the competition fields at any time!
- 5. Dogs are not to be left overnight in outdoor benching spaces.

6. ALL DAY TENTS MUST BE SECURLEY TIED DOWN AND TOP DROPPED AT THE END OF EACH DAY.

- 7. <u>Grass mats are not permitted</u> in the day tenting areas of the North American and the All Alberta Fields.
- 8. Generators (civilized ones please, excessively loud generators will not be permitted) are permitted in the day tenting area, however the generators must be housed up against the fence line and at no time are to infringe on your neighbors' space so that exhaust fumes would enter their area. Please ensure you have a long extension cord if you are using a generator.

Security is on site from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. daily.

9. You are responsible for leaving your space as you found it.... **CLEAN!** Please ensure that you have a rake/tool handy to clean up your area, left behind garbage, dog hair, rubber bands, etc. are not the responsibility of the Alberta Kennel Club Volunteers or Spruce Meadows Personnel to clean up. We thank you for your cooperation in this regard!

10. All outdoor benching must be vacated 1 hour following Best in Show on Monday, Aug 7, 2023.

Un-Reserved Outdoor Benching:

West side of K-Barn only – available Thursday August 3, 2023 @ 2 pm

Dog Bathing:

-We have 4 stalls available on the south side of the horse wash bays, complete with hot and cold running water, all complete with bath tubs. Please be advised that this water is non-potable and not for drinking.

Concessions:

- The Time Faults Pub is open at 7 am to 11 am daily for breakfast, and open the rest of the day until 9 pm for lunch or dinner. (Friday to Monday) **unless private functions are scheduled for the evening**

- There are concession stands on the East end of the horse wash bays as well as the SE entrance of the North American Field. (Friday to Monday)

Recycle, Garbage & Dog Poop:

- You are TOTALLY responsible for picking up after your dog. Spruce Meadows and the Alberta Kennel Club have ZERO tolerance for dog droppings on the grounds. Let us be responsible and set a great example keeping the grounds pristine. **Exhibitors who are found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the show immediately.**

- All Exhibitors are responsible for putting their recyclables, garbage, and hair in the large garbage bins. Please leave your benching areas clean at the end of the show as a courtesy to Spruce Meadows and the volunteers who run the show.

Urgent Medical Call Procedure:

Have one person with the guest requiring medical attention call 9-1-1 and direct the ambulance to the Front Gate off Spruce Meadows Way at 18011 Spruce Meadows Way. If there is another person at the scene, please have them call the AKC on-site contact Tina Gaudet at 403 619-3212. If there is not a second person on-site, please call Tina immediately after calling 9-1-1 to ensure we can deploy protocol to meet the ambulance.
An AKC representative will head to the scene and stay with the guest requiring medical attention and will also call the Spruce Meadows Security Line to have the security team meet and escort the ambulance from the front gate to the scene.

Non-Urgent Medical Call Procedure:

- Call AKC contact, Tina Gaudet at 403 619-3212 and have her get in contact with Spruce Meadows Security to meet at the scene of the guest requiring attention.

- Assess the situation and call the ambulance as required. Spruce Meadows Security Line to have the security team meet and escort the ambulance from the front gate to the scene.

-This is a world class Equestrian Centre which welcomes people from around the world and we must treat this venue with the respect it is due.

- Do not allow the male dogs to lift their legs on fences, posts, trees, or shrubs.
- Failure to pick-up after your dogs will result in expulsion from the show and the show grounds.

The Alberta Kennel Club will not be responsible for the loss or injury to any dog, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether a result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody, and control of the owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

ANIMALS LEFT IN VEHICLES – *The Owner* of an *Animal* must not leave an *Animal* unattended in a motor vehicle when the temperature outdoors is below minus 15 degrees Celsius or above plus 15 degrees Celsius. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner will be subject to penalty under the Animal Protection Act 2(1) (1.1) 2.1©. The Alberta Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility for damage to any vehicle entered to remove an animal(s) in distress

Each club will have a different location for accepting entries for their Junior Handling event - most will be ringside just before their specialty. But each will be listed in their individual Judging schedule - entries will NOT be being taken at the Show Secretary or AKC table - and there is no Junior Tent this year.

**** ATTENTION CONFORMATION AND RALLY-OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS ****

Due to Judging overloads, some of the breed judging has been modified. The Group assignments remain the same as posted in the premium list. Please check the Judging Assignments following below, all changes after close of entries are in RED.

Unfortunately Suzanne Hemminger is no longer able to come and judge, Lisbeth Booth has kindly agreed to take on all of her assignments. Please check the Judging Assignments following below, all changes after close of entries are in RED.

The following CKC rules apply for the replacement judge and for the overload:

CKC RULE 3.3.1 "... Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to one (1) hour before the JUDGING OF THE BREED, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded. An exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one (1) of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees, will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to one (1) hour prior to the START OF THE SHOW."

CKC RULE 3.5.1 When entries close, and the club determines that the total number of dogs entered under a judge exceeds 175 at breed level, the club in question must seek approval from the CKC to transfer a sufficient number of dogs to another judge to reduce the total number to 175. One or more regular classes shall be reassigned until the original assignment is brought as closely as possible to 175 dogs. Exhibitors affected by the change may withdraw their entries up to one (1) hour before judging of the breed, providing that notice of withdrawal is made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded. Similarly, a dog entered at the show but not under the judge drawing an overload, may enter under the substitute judge as provided for in Section 8.5.

Exhibitors, Please note:

- All Adult Group judging and Best in Show judging will be held in Ring # 8, Best Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy Group, and Veteran Group will be in Ring #7 on the North American field. Group judging will follow the last breed each day. Throughout the day; Individual breeds, dogs and classes will NOT be paged. Exhibitors and handlers with more than one dog must have an alternate handler available.

- For your convenience the division of sexes has been carefully tabulated, however the Alberta Kennel Club does not assume responsibility for absolute accuracy. The number before each breed is the total number of that breed; following the breed is the following division - males - females - special males - special females. * Denotes booster and/or supported entry.

- Dogs must enter the show premises 1 (one) hour prior to the scheduled judging of the breed. Dogs which are not required for further judging may leave the show grounds after their judging is completed.





The Examination

- 1. A short health survey regarding the dog's breathing history.
- 2. A brief physical exam while the dog is calm including auscultation where the assessor listens to the dog's breathing with a stethoscope gently positioned on the side of the neck. This establishes a baseline for any clinical signs of BOAS.
- 3. A short exercise testing consisting of a brisk three-minute walk. This is designed to expose clinical signs of the disease in an otherwise calm and asymptomatic dog. It is not designed to asses cardiovascular fitness.
- 4. A post exercise auscultation after increased airway activity to compare to the pre-exercise baseline.

RFG Scheme Screening

The noise the trained veterinarians are listening for during auscultation include:

- Stertor a low pitched vibrational noise heard above the level of the larynx
- Stridor higher pitched 'sawing' noise heard over the larynx
- Nasal stertor low pitched nasal snort/vibration
- Nasal stridor high pitched nasal whistle, usually on breathing in

RFG Scheme - What Does the Grading Mean?

The Respiratory Function Grading Scheme (RFGS) utilizes a sliding scale of 0 to 3 to objectively diagnosis BOAS:

- **Grade 0** the dog is clinically unaffected and free of respiratory signs of BOAS (no evidence of disease, no BOAS related noise heard even with a stethoscope)
- Grade 1 the dog is clinically unaffected but have mild respiratory signs linked to BOAS (noise is mild and only audible with a stethoscope)
- Grade 2 the dog is clinically affected and has moderate respiratory signs of BOAS (noise is audible even without a stethoscope)
- Grade 3 the dog is clinically affected and has severe respiratory signs of BOAS (noise is audible even without a stethoscope)

Publication of Results

Grade 0 and Grade 1 - are considered clinically normal and BOAS unaffected as they exercise without difficulty and do not appear to have any clinical signs related to airway obstruction.

Clinically normal dogs (Grade 0 and 1) will receive OFA certificate numbers, and their results will be posted on the OFA website.

Grade 2 and Grade 3 - when stertor or stridor noise is heard without a stethoscope, whether intermittent or continuous, these dogs are considered affected with clinical signs affecting their quality or life.

Grade 2 or 3 results will only be posted on the OFA website if their owners authorize release of abnormal data.

BOAS Breeding Recommendations

Using the RFG Scheme grades are the guidelines in the chart, concerned responsible breeders can apply the selective genetic pressure to reduce the chances of producing puppies affected by BOAS.


However, since the inheritance of BOAS is not fully understood and is not entirely predictable, this guideline cannot guarantee that all puppies from unaffected parents will be free of BOAS.


Ultimately, responsible breeders use the RFG Scheme to screen their breeding stock and include the results in their selection criteria.




