## IMPORTANT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

1. There will be no kenneling.
2. Only one handler and one dog in the building at a time during the test.
3. Masks are optional.
4. For the Judge's Briefings, all participants are encouraged to follow social distancing protocols.
5. Participants must adhere to all Province of Saskatchewan Regulations in place at the time of the match, including not attending the event if they are sick, have any COVID-19 symptoms or have been in contact with persons with COVID-19.

## IMPORTANT

### CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Match Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
- **Scent Detection Levels offered** – Instinct, Novice (Containers, Interior and Exterior) Open (Containers, Interior, Exterior) and Excellent (Containers, Interior, Exterior), Master (Containers, Interior, Exterior). Exhibitors can compete in same level components with a maximum of two dogs.
- Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this Match. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number) issued by the Canadian Kennel Club in order to participate in these Match.

- **Bitches in season** - bitches in season are not permitted to compete (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5). We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate. The certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.
- **Penalties issued by the club** – handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment by dogs (including urinating on items, excessive scratching, or subsequent breaking of any item).
- **Reminder** – that anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.
