Equipment and course familiarization:

- Electronic Timers will be used.
- Rubberized Contacts
- There will be NO contact equipment familiarization.
- A warm up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials.
- NO toys that make squeaky sounds will be permitted within 15 feet of the rings.

C.K.C. Agility Trial Rep for AB:

- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class
- As per CKC Rules move ups are allowed one hour prior to commencement of the start of each trial each day. Same day move ups will be allowed.
- Day of entries allowed (space permitting) up to one hour prior to the commencement of the start of trials each day.
- We will try to accommodate dogs with conflicts in conformation/obedience/rally provided handlers inform gate stewards in advance, however we cannot hold the rings. Handlers please call out your dog's name to the scribe when entering the ring.

CKC AGILITY HEIGHT CLASSES

Height Divisions - owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

REGULAR CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase, Jumps and Tunnels & PAD

SELECTED CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase Jumps and Tunnels & PAD

VETERANS CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase Jumps and Tunnels & PAD

The following breeds, or mixed breed dogs that resemble these breeds in relation to weight to shoulder height ratios, are permitted (but not required) to jump either ONE or TWO jump height(s) lower than the designated shoulder height when they show in the Selected division.

Small Breeds: Basset Hound, Bulldog, Cesky Terrier, Clumber spaniel, Dachshund (all six varieties), Dandie Dinmont Terrier, French bulldog, Pekingese, Petit Basset Griffon Vendeen, Scottish Terrier, Sealyham Terrier, Skye Terrier, Welsh Corgi (Cardigan & Pembroke)

Giant Breeds: Bernese Mountain Dog, Black Russian Terrier, Bloodhound, Bullmastiff, Great Dane, Great Pyrenees, Greater Swiss Mountain Dog, Irish Wolfhound, Leonberger, Mastiff, Neopolitan Mastiff, Newfoundland, Saint Bernard

Entries will be accepted after the pre-entry deadline with the following conditions:

- There will be no discount packages allowed; the price of each run will be \$30.00.
- Entry must be received by 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial being entered.
- Additional classes added after pre-entry closing to an existing entry will be processed at the exhibitor's previous discount, no further discounts will be applied.
- FFO* (For Fun Only) Runs are NOT included in the discounted total run fee. No refunds will be given for any difference in fees already paid if an exhibitor switches a regular run to a FFO run at the trial.
- CASH ONLY FOR POST CLOSING ENTRIES
- NO Refunds will be given after early bird close of entries (July 24, 2023 at 10pm MDT) except in the case of a bitch in season or an injured dog see rules below.

VOLUNTEER RULES

ANYONE volunteering or AKC representative who is in the ring is NOT to have a cell phone, or any food or drink except water. For liability reasons, <u>ALL</u> "ring Crew" (volunteer/AKC representative) must be AT least 14 years of age unless previously approved by the AKC Agility committee. Proof of age may be requested. There will be volunteer basket draw for each day.

Bitch in Season

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Agility, Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the starting date and time of the trial. The Alberta Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and TCN fees if the above conditions are met. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

Injured Dogs (12-05-19)

6.11.1 If a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3 day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The trial-giving club may refund the entry fee but will keep a service charge and TCN fee. The refund and the terms thereof must be clearly stated in the premium list. The Alberta Kennel Club will be keeping a \$5/run service fee and any TCN fees collected (if applicable).

No other refunds will be issued after early bird closing (July 24, 2023).

AGILITY ONLY BENCHING

<u>Very limited space</u> will be available free of charge under a Day Benching tent. Spots will be first come first served and once the tent is filled no other spots will be made available. <u>Nothing</u> can remain in the Day Benching tent overnight.

No benching is allowed other than the prepaid reserved benching. You will be asked to move if you are benched outside of designated benching areas.

- No Grass Mats permitted on the fields
- No tents with floors This will be STRICTLY enforced!!
- There are NO Generators allowed on the field
- Please make sure ALL tents are securely staked and lowered each night.

Dogs not entered in the Show(s) are not permitted on the show premises.

Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their judging (allowing for absentees). It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled to run. Waiting for dogs will not be possible if you have a conflict, please let the Gate Steward know IN ADVANCE.

AGILITY PRIZES

Jennifer Chipperfield of **CHIPPERFIELD PHOTOGRAPHY** is pleased to offer 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place cash prizes in the amounts of \$175, \$150, \$100 and \$50 respectively to the agility top dogs achieving the top 4 aggregate scores in Standard and JWW Classes in the CKC Agility Trials being held from August 4 to 7, 2023. In the case of a tie, prize money for that place and the one(s) below it (if applicable) will be combined and then split between those competitors. Steeplechase, Jumps & Tunnels and PAD scores will not be considered when calculating placements for the cash prizes. Prizes may be mailed out.

<u>Again, this year</u>: To be eligible for these prizes, competitors <u>must</u> obtain a tracking sheet from the Trial Secretary to record the dog's qualifying runs. This form must be completed and submitted to the Trial Secretary's desk within 1/2 hour of the completion of the Standard Runs/Jumpers with Weaves runs on Monday.

The points will be awarded as follows for each Qualifying run earned over the two days:

Novice:	2 pts
Intermediate:	3 pts
Excellent:	4 pts
Master Excellent:	5 pts

JUNIOR HANDLER PRIZE – Marnie Harrison and Praderia Spanish Water Dogs is pleased to offer a prize to the Junior Handler (Under 18 as of Aug 1, 2023) achieving the most qualifying Standard runs with one or more dogs over the 4 days of trials. To be eligible, Junior Handlers must sign up at the Agility Secretary's desk by noon Saturday, Aug 5, 2023. In the case of a tie, the prize will be split between those competitors.

Flat Ribbons will be provided for all dogs receiving a qualifying score & $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ in each height class. Rosettes will be provided for dogs earning new titles. Rosettes will also be provided for dogs achieving Agility Master Champion.

BOOSTERS

NEW THIS YEAR - TRACKING SHEET FOR BOOSTER PRIZES!!!

In order to streamline the prizes this year, and to ensure that everyone gets their prize in a timely manner, AKC has decided to have prize tracking sheets for boosters. To be eligible for these prizes, competitors <u>must</u> obtain a tracking sheet from the Trial Secretary to record the dog's qualifying runs. This form must be completed and submitted to the Trial Secretary's desk within 15 minutes of the completion of the trials on Saturday.

Agility Booster Prizes will be available for pick up after Noon on Sunday. Any booster prizes not picked up by the end of the day on Monday will be considered a donation to AKC to be used for future prizes.

No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, Act of God, or any other cause beyond the control of the Alberta Kennel Club.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Planning Your Stay at the Summer Classic

The Alberta Kennel Club is pleased to be holding our show once again at Spruce Meadows. Holding our event here comes with some significant responsibilities for all of us – volunteers and exhibitors alike.

This is a world class Equestrian Centre which welcomes people from around the world and we must treat this venue with the respect it is due.

- Clean up after your dog
- Do not allow your male dogs to lift their legs on fences, posts, trees or shrubs

PLEASE KEEP BAGGIES WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES.

Failure to pick-up after your dogs will result in an automatic expulsion from the show and the show grounds.

This request will be enforced

Some Basic Requests:

- 1. Spruce Meadows does not allow overnight tenting on their grounds.
- 2. Parking will be allowed only in areas designated by the Parking Superintendent.
- 3. All RVs must have boards under all their tires and generators in Lot 10; heavy units parked on pavement should have boards under their jacks sorry, No Exceptions!
- 4. Please be prepared to bring leveling materials for your unit.
- 5. For all RVs, please ensure you have your exhaust pipe extension, this is mandatory.
- 6. There will be absolutely NO dumping of grey water or sewage on Spruce Meadows grounds.
- 7. Water & electrical hook-ups are not available for RV units.
- 8. All parking is at your own risk:

- a. THE ALBERTA KENNEL CLUB IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR WEATHER RELATED DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY. PLEASE BE PREPARED FOR UNFORSEEN EVENTS, ESPECIALLY WIND AND/OR HAIL.
- b. Please ensure that awnings are down and/or secured if you are leaving the show grounds.
- 9. We offer Complimentary Showers for our exhibitors *The Alberta Kennel Club greatly appreciates any donations towards offsetting the cost of the showers.*
- 10. Generators Please ensure they are off between the hours of 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM this is the designated "quiet time" for our friends and neighbors.
- 11. If you must leave the show grounds, dogs in your care must be moved inside. DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN ANY OUTDOOR ENCLOSURE. FAILURE TO COMPLY may result in excusal from the show.
- 12. All Set -ups are required to have a contact phone number posted in case of emergency.
- 13. All indoor and outdoor benching must be vacated 1 hour following Best in Show on Monday Aug 7, 2023.

Absolutely no private golf carts are permitted on the North American Ring or All Alberta Ring at any time.


Golf carts are also confined to the of the Precincts of the Summer Classic Show
