In Regards to the farm hosting this year's event at 175290 Concession 6, Dornoch Ontario, Midwest Cooperative Service was hired to scout for the following list of grasses; California needle, Canada wild rye, Downy brome, Foxtail barley, Meadow barley, mouse barley, Needle and thread, Nimble weed, Oldfield three awn, Purple three awn, Red three awn, Ripgut brome, Single awn aridtida, Sleepy grass, Virginia wild rye, Western needle grass, Wild barley, and Winter red top.

When the grounds were evaluated a considerable amount of Smooth Brome was found. Downy brome is visually very similar to smooth brome. The surfaces of both leaves and sheaths are covered with short and dense hairs. With a similar seed head, and a dropping panicle. For confirmation of the species, samples were sent to the University of Guelph Herbaceous Curator who confirmed two bio types where both Smooth Brome (*Bromus inermis*). It was not determined that any other species of concern were located on the even grounds.
