### DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:

**Please Note:** If you haven't been to our Ottewell site before and are bringing an RV – **DO NOT GPS the address!** See directions which follow. The city address will take you through a residential neighbourhood with no access to general RV Parking.

**Directions to the show site: Google or Garmin main hub: 50<sup>th</sup> Street and 101 Avenue (Also called Baseline Road).**

All RV's must enter at the access off 101 Avenue (Baseline Road). **RV PARKING – From South** – Follow Gateway Blvd. North to Whitemud Drive, then East to exit 50<sup>th</sup> Street North (up off Ramp, Turn Left) Continue on 50<sup>th</sup> Street to 101 Avenue, Turn Right at 101 and then next Left at the first traffic lights. **From North or West** – Yellowhead Trail, exit on Wayne Gretzky Drive South to 101 Avenue, then Left past 50<sup>th</sup> Street and Left at the next traffic lights. **From East:** Yellowhead Trail exit 17<sup>th</sup> Street South to 101 Avenue, Turn Right, Continue on 101 Avenue Past ESSO Strathcona refinery and turn Right at first lights past refinery (Tiger Goldstick Park Sign) **Vehicle Parking & Handicapped Parking** – at 50<sup>th</sup> Street and Baseline Road go North past little strip mall, turn RIGHT at the big steel post, Continue turning Right at intersections until you come to the curling building. Handicapped parkers - you MUST have pre-booked and must display a VALID handicap sticker. No exceptions, thank you!

**RV's AT THIS SHOW:** Once again we have a large number of RV's at this show, and because of VERY strict City of Edmonton and City Fire Marshall regulations – **IT IS ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY THAT YOU FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE RV PARKING STAFF!!!** Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the show and future NACA shows. NO EXCEPTIONS, thank you for understanding!

### **RV Parking will commence Thursday at 3:00pm.**

You are welcome to line up at the gate prior to 3pm, but you will not be parked before 3:00 *unless* the WHOLE show is set up earlier. If you see RV's on the grounds, they are NACA members and volunteers who are setting up the show, or **COMMERCIAL BOOTHS** which will be let in at noon.

All RV spots must have been booked in advance – all spaces have been filled and there is no room for those who did not pre-book. If you did not reserve and pay for a spot please check Edmonton and Sherwood Park campgrounds. There is a Walmart in the neighbourhood as well.

**NOTE:** If you arrive after 10pm please do not take it upon yourself to park where you want to!!! Last year we had a late arrival who parked in our small handicapped parking area and refused to move!! Don't let this be you!! We will publicly post offenders and they will not be allowed at future NACA shows. There is a Walmart a few blocks away...

**TENT CITY** – If you reserved and paid for a tent spot please check in with the parking people at the gate who will direct you to the day tent area. If you did not reserve a spot please park your vehicle and look for a spot on the berms or around the fence edges. No vehicles are to be left at the day tent area. **SPECIALTY TENTS:** some of our 18 specialties have booked group day tent spots. Please check with your specialty contacts.

**DAY VEHICLE PARKING** – Due to the large entry we are expecting that day parking is going to be tight. Please arrive plenty of time before your judging in order to find a parking place. Please park where directed. If parking to the south of the field is full, please go around to the North of the building and park on the residential streets. **Do not block driveways or park in NO Parking zones – by-law officers WILL be out writing tickets.**

**HANDICAPPED PARKING** – At the front of the building, limited number, MUST display valid handicapped sticker.

**All exhibitors parking RV's or benching in day tents will be identified by spot AFTER set-up in order that we will be able to identify those who do not leave their spot as clean as it was when they came. Lately our few overly exhausted club members had some disgusting!! messes to clean up and will not tolerate this disrespect again. Those who do not comply will not be welcomed back to future shows and trials.**



**IMPORTANT!!! IMPORTANT!!! IMPORTANT!!! PLEASE READ!**  
**DRIVING OF ANY VEHICLES ON THE GROUNDS DURING SHOW HOURS IS PROHIBITED!!**

For five days our Ottewell show site is home for families with children and dogs. During the day there are children playing and not paying attention to what is happening around them. And occasionally we have had the odd dog escape. Insurance and other restrictions make it necessary for us to enforce this rule – **no driving on the grounds during show hours.** In an emergency the show will be stopped and vehicle will be escorted out. **SLOW** driving during the lunch hour and after the show is over will be allowed. Thank you for taking care of your fellow canine family!

**NACA JUNIOR HANDLING** – Conformation and Obedience Junior Handling will be held on Saturday during the lunch break. Juniors register at the NACA TENT on Saturday morning starting at 10:00 until 11:30. \$2.00 fee

**THURSDAY NIGHT OBEDIENCE 10 FOR \$15.00 MAT TIME – ALBERTA OBEDIENCE GROUP** – in the building Obedience rings approx 4pm

**THURSDAY NIGHT CONFORMATION SANCTION MATCH – EDMONTON SAMOYED CLUB** – outside unless inclement weather necessitates moving inside. Judge: Dr. Will Friend. If you did not enter on-line post entries will be taken at 5pm at the NACA club tent. A chance for your dogs to practice in the ring before the “real thing”. The match will start at approximately 6pm.

**SATURDAY NIGHT - BEST IN SHOW RING & NACA TENT AREA** – we invite everyone to join us in remembering our late member (and very much missed) Jolie Janssen. At her request we will be celebrating her life with her Janterra/Avid Doberman Pinschers and Chinese Crested Dogs by presenting a special rosette to the winner of **Best Puppy in Show** – she loved her puppies! This special rosette is inscribed as follows: “in memory of Jolie Janssen, a friend, member, breeder, wife and mother. ### **Notice of Judge Changes (Conformation)**

\*Exhibitors affected by the change may withdraw their entries up to one (1) hour before judging of the breed, providing that notice of withdrawal is made in writing. All entry and list fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded. Similarly, a dog entered at the show but not under the judge drawing an overload may enter under the substitute judge as provided for in Section 8.5.8 of the CKC Dog Show Rules.

Due to Judge Overload the following judge changes have been made:

**Friday:**

Great Danes will now be judged by Delvina Beaulac.

**Sunday:**

Mastiffs and Newfoundlands will now be judged by Dann Wilson.

As per the revised Premium List posted on April 8th:

Unfortunately, Jeff Lunder is no longer able to come and judge for the NACA Show this year. Luckily, Lionel Whittaker has kindly agreed to take over Jeff Lunder's Assignment. In this situation the following CKC rules apply: 3.4.4 A qualifying score earned under a substitute or replacement judge will be considered as having been earned under the advertised judge. 3.4.2 All those who have entered dogs under the advertised judge shall be allowed to withdraw at any time prior to judging of that trial. All requests for withdrawal shall be in writing and all entry fees and listing fees will be returned to the owner or the authorized agent of the dog. When possible, the trial-giving club will attempt to notify exhibitors of the judging change at the time the judging schedule is sent out.

Thank you all for your acceptance of the rules we have to enforce – and know that we have tried our best to make this show an enjoyable one for everyone, despite the complications which arise at a show of this size.
