ENTRIES OPEN/CLOSE: Entries **OPEN FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2025, at 7:00 PM, AND CLOSE FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2025, at 7:00 PM**, or when limit is reached. Day of show entry will be available if trial does not fill. Any entries submitted early will be rejected and bumped to the waitlist.

ENTRY LIMITS: 8 hours of judging per day.

ENTRY FEES:

\$26.25 (\$25.00+GST) per entry Levels I, II, & Games

\$31.50 (\$30.00+GST) per entry Level III & ULGCH

Day of Show and Late Entry: \$36.75 (\$35.00+GST) per entry all levels. There is no guarantee of a day of show entry.

DOG REGISTRATION:

Dogs must be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association to enter these trials. Registration is a one-time fee charged by the association in USD. You may register your dog online at <http://nasda.dog/registration/>

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each trial. Ribbons are awarded for Qualifying Score, Best of Breed and High in Class where applicable. New title ribbons will be awarded.

VENUE:

- Saturday trials will be held at 96189 – 2253 Drive East, Foothills, AB T1S 4V4
- Porta potty will be available on site. The porta potties will be cleaned and sanitizer and available for your use.
- Please bring your own food and drinks for you and your dog(s).
- Kool-Key Sniff Club reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises.
- Do not arrive prior to site opening.

BENCHING:

- Exhibitors must bench in their vehicles; no indoor benching is available.
- All dogs must be crated safely and securely when not working. ODgs may not be left tethered or tied up to vehicles, tents, fences or other structures. Please secure zippers on soft crates with a security clip to secure dog(s) in crate. **NOT ACCEPTABLE** crates include those tht do not have a solid frame once together keep the crate stationary, ie. Pop-ups. **NO X-PENS** allowed on site.

PARKING:

- Follow directional signage and park in approved parking only. A map of the facility, with marked parking and trial grounds boundaries will be sent with competitors' welcome email.

WAIVERS:

- Waivers must be signed yearly for the sport of NASDA at Kool-Key Sniff Club. You will not be permitted to run without a valid waiver, every person in your party must sign a waiver, including but not limited to spouses, guests, parents/guardians must sign a waiver for minors under 18 years of age.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- No refunds for cancellations after the closing date or for entries which are absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Refunds will be mailed no later than 7 days after the event.
- Porta-Potties are available on-site.
- No vaping/smoking on the grounds. If you must vape/smoke, please do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle or leave the trial grounds. Anyone found vaping/smoking on-site will be asked to leave the event grounds, no refunds will be issued.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dog, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on a leash, six feet or less in length, at all times except when competing where permissible. No flexi or extendable leashes allowed on site. No electronic collars or devices are allowed on the property (electronic, barking collars, citronella).

- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog. Do **NOT** potty your dog(s) on buildings, vehicles, garbage cans, or anything not natural. Failure to clean up after your dog will result in immediate dismissal from the trial.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run. The Judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class because he exhibitor is not ready. It is the exhibitor’s responsibility to be ready for their runs. Kool-Key Sniff Club has no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the line when required.
- Bitches in season are permitted and must wear panties when not crated or potting. They will run last in their class. Please inform the secretary as soon as possible so the running order can be updated to accommodate the change.
- An initial confirmation will be sent out soon after entry received with a final confirmation sent by **MARCH 8, 2024.**
- Move ups can be made between trials (for example, if you Qualify and earn your Level I Title on Trial 1 of Urban Locator, you can run trial 2 at Level II) please make the judge aware of a potential move up and immediately report same to Trial Secretary so the run orders can be adjusted.
- Gerbils are used in place of rates in Alberta.
- Spectators may stand around the areas but may be asked to move if needed for physical distance for dog/handler movement.

ENTRY FORMS AND WAIVERS:

- **Entry Registration is located at Dogshow.ca. (link will go live near trial opening date).**
- Waivers will be provided with your entry confirmation and will be required to be returned to secure your entries.
