CKC Scent Detection Rules and regulations

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. All entries must be made through www.dogshow.ca

Limit of 2 dogs per handler per component.

All fees include H.S.T. and must be paid in Canadian Funds.

Eligibility: This event is open to all breeds, including eligible mixed breeds or unrecognized breeds. Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following:

- a) Registered with the CKC
- b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
- d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
- e) Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches, a dog must meet the requirements above; and:

- a) Must be at least 6 months of age.
- b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked.
- c) Must not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame).
- d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability.

Multiple Dogs: No limit on Instinct. Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than TWO (2) dogs in the same class / components in Novice, Open, or Excellent. I.e.: Three novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the match. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Scent Detection comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial.

Immunization: The CKC Rules and Regulations for shows, trials and tests have explicit rules to minimise the transmission of communicable diseases. A dog may not be entered or exhibited at a show, trial, match, or test if it has or has been exposed to any communicable disease.

Host Facility Information: No indoor crating. Match will run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, and secured on a leash, except where off leash searches are permitted during the match. Non-trial odor is forbidden on the trial grounds. No warmup area will be offered. Washroom facilities are available indoors.

Parking available on either side of the building except for where marked.

Please clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event with no refund.

We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities and the trial facility is wheelchair accessible. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

No lunch will be provided. Restaurants, grocery, and fast food are available 5 km from the site.
