## Run Order

Prairie Dog Sports Inc. reserves the right to change the run order based on entries and will send final class run order and judging schedule confirmation one week prior to the start of the trial. Dogs being handled by the same person must be separated into different staged groups.

Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to Event start or as the first dogs of the Event.

## Move-ups

Forms will be available at the Secretary's table. Previous trial move-ups must be submitted no later than 7:00 pm MDT March 10, 2026, via email to the Trial Secretary. Same day move-ups must be submitted no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the trial you choose to move-up in. Next day move-ups must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the finish of afternoon trials.

## Day of Show Entries

All competitors will have to have a valid BHA registration number prior to submitting their entry form.

Day of Show Entries will be received during check-in each day.

Day of Show entries are not a guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to Judging limits.

Confirmations will not be sent for Day of Show entries.

## Awards

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in all classes, including Instinct. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> in each height division for all classes except Instinct. New title ribbons and High in Class ribbons will also be awarded. Ribbon tabs will be provided for all new titles. B Classes will receive 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup>, with one HIC for all height divisions combined. Master B will receive 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup>, per height division.

Line drive: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers and placements 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> all heights combined.

Custom rosettes or a special prize (the choice of) will be awarded to those who earn any RATCH title. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Trial Officials.

**\*\*NEW\*\*** We will be offering a “High Overall” prize for each class (A & B combined), and for crazy 8s. This will be awarded on Sunday

Dogs do not need to be entered the entire weekend, and you do not need to be present to win.

Dogs will accumulate points for each qualifying run, and for every second they are under the allotted time.

Dogs may only win one prize per event. If they are entered in multiple levels they will win the class with the most points. In the event of a tie, the dog with more Qs will be awarded. In the event of an another tie, the dog with the fastest time will be awarded.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Prairie Dog Sports Inc. reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Facility is handicapped/wheelchair accessible.

Facility is an enclosed, indoor space with dirt floor.

Rings are indoor and enclosed with 4' X 9' metal fencing.

Indoor Blinds are 20'X10' tent with chairs located a minimum of 15' away from the rings

You **MUST** park where directed.

**Note:** Gerbils are used in place of rats in Alberta.

It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any participant whose dog(s) create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Prairie Dog Sports Inc. and all persons associated with running this event will assume no responsibilities for any loss damage or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dog's or property.

**Entries made without fees or signature and a completed Waiver and Indemnity Form will not be accepted.**

- If you provide your email address, we will acknowledge receipt of your entry via email within a few days. If you do not receive an initial confirmation within one week of submitting your entry, contact the Trial Secretary. Any errors must be reported to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trial.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (6') and under control at all times, while on trial grounds, except when in the ring for judging. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed.
- Dog **must** run “naked,” without a collar/harness. *The actual course area will be securely enclosed.* **No flexi-leads or head halters allowed within the facility.** Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site – this includes electronic bark collars. Concealed Prong collars may be used on the site while walking dogs for getting to and from the blind and ring.
- Bitches in season may compete. They will run at the end of each class. They **must** wear “pants” at all times when not being pottied, **including on the course. Owners of bitches in season should confine their dog(s) away from the trial area and other dogs, post “dog in season” signs in their area, and potty their dog(s) away from other competitors.** Owners should make their condition known to the Trial Secretary **prior to the start of the trials** and inform all exhibitors **at the judge's briefing.**
- The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class because the exhibitor is not ready. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready for their runs. **Prairie Dog Sports Inc. has no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.**
- There will be a short lunch break at the judges discretion.
- **BHA rules and common courtesy:** Exhibitors are responsible to clean up after their dogs. Dispose of waste in appropriate containers provided around the facility.
- Possessing or training with personal, live quarry is not permitted on trial grounds at any time. Food and toys are **not** permitted in the ring. Squeaky toys are **not** permitted in the facility.
- These trials are held indoors. No benching indoors will be available



**There is NO SMOKING/VAPING in this facility.** If you must smoke/vape please do so **inside your vehicle** and dispose of the butts in the vehicle. Anyone found smoking around the facility will be asked to leave the event grounds. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

## WITHDRAWAL & REFUND POLICY

- Competitors who withdraw any or all entries from a Fun Test, Trial or Trials prior to the closing date will receive a refund of all entry fees, minus any non-refundable credit card/Dogshow transaction fees, if applicable.
- Competitors who withdraw any or all entries from a Fun Test, Trial or Trials after the closing date are not eligible for a refund. Only exception is if runs are filled off the waitlist, will a refund be issued (Minus any non-refundable fees)
  - If you have read this far, thank you for reading all the rules and tiny details.
- Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid minus any non-refundable credit card/Dogshow transaction fees, if applicable, upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the trial on Sunday afternoon. Priority mail is not necessary. - Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee(s) will not be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Abuse of any kind towards volunteers or trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event.

# Facility Rules of Conduct



## WHAT CAN I ENTER MY DOG IN?

### GENERAL RULES

**No nose to nose contact with other dogs.** You are here to work and engage with your dog.

If a dog is handled in an aggressive or inappropriate manner a warning may be issued or the team may be asked to leave without refund(s).

Please show courtesy to all participants. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they are reactive or spatially challenged.

Remain aware of what your dog is doing at all times. Every dog and participant deserve to have a pleasant experience.

No chairs are allowed in the trial area

No dogs lingering in the trial area before or after their run. Please promptly exit the building after your runs.

A photo booth will be set up till 30 mins after the completion of Sundays trial.

A NQ and volunteer draw will be drawn daily after the completion of the afternoon trial.

### CRATING OF YOUR DOG

All dogs must be crated safely and securely when not working. **DO NOT** tie your dog(s) to anything.

**DO NOT** approach crated dogs. If you do not have permission from the dog's owner, you are not permitted to approach a crated dog.

**DO NOT** let your dog(s) approach a crated dog(s).

You may crate your dog(s) from your vehicle, weather permitting. Dogs crated in vehicles may be monitored by Prairie Dog Sports Inc. to safeguard the welfare of the dog(s).

**Acceptable crates** include crates which have a solid frame once together to keep the crate stationary, i.e. soft crate, wire crate. Please secure zippers on soft crates with security clip to secure dog(s) in crate.

**Not acceptable crates** include x-pens and those that do not have a solid frame once together to keep the crate stationary, i.e. pop-ups.

From Robin:

What does it mean?

Clubs can offer up to two Trials per day. A collection of Trials over consecutive days is called an Event. So a typical weekend is 6 trials total, 2 per day, for an Event. Currently, you can enter both Instinct and Novice during the same Trial until you get your Novice title. Other than that, you choose ONE regular class to enter per trial. e.g. you enter Open A in both Trial 1 and Trial 2, running your dog twice that day. With the new option, you can enter twice in each TRIAL, running your dog 4 times in one day in the regular classes.

Options:

You cannot enter the same class twice in the same Trial.

Here are your options for entry:

Novice B + Open A  
Novice B + Senior A  
Novice B + Master A  
Novice B + Open B  
Novice B + Senior B  
Novice B + Master B  
Open B + Senior A  
Open B + Master A  
Open B + Senior B  
Open B + Master B  
Senior B + Master A  
Senior B + Master B

This change does not apply to Crazy 8s or to Line Drive.

In closing, do keep in mind your own dog's energy levels. Four runs a day can be a lot for some dogs. Also, allowing clubs to do this will pinch their volunteer pool. Be willing to step in and help as needed.
